Hon'ble Chief Minister Sri K. Chandrashekar Rao has announced an amount of Rs. 25 Crores as immediate assistance towards Kerala Flood relief fund. CM has instructed Chief Secretary Sri SK. Joshi to handover this amount to Kerala State Government.

CM has also instructed the officials concerned, that, in view of water getting polluted due to floods, Reverse Osmosis Water Purifiers worth Rs. 2.50 Crores should also be despatched to Kerala.

CM said that as Kerala State is in trouble due to heavy rains and floods, it is the responsibility of Telangana people to come to that state's rescue. CM has given a call to the industrialists, IT companies and others in Telangana to come forward and help the Kerala State in this hour of crisis.
